1930 Federal Census

In 1930, Claude and his family lived in Perham in Aroostook County, ME. Four-year-old Claude was the second youngest of Vaughn and Isabel's five children. Vaughn worked as a laborer on a farm and the family rented their home for \$5 a month.

The 1940 census shows the Chase family with their sixth child, Vivian. It also shows that during the Great Depression, Claude's family moved from Perham to the town of Madison in Somerset County.

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Hospital Record, 1945

Claude's hospital admission record from January 1945. It reveals that a head wound from artillery shell fragments ultimately killed him after reaching a field hospital for treatment. Claude was only nineteen years old.

The rest of the division closed in Marseille France 14 Jan 45 and the division assembled at Willerswald on 2 Feb 45 as Task Force Harris was discontinued. fought through the region north of the Jagst River 3 Apr 45. The 253rd forced the river in the Griesheim-Herbolzheim region on 4 Apr 45 and fought house-to-house in Moeckmuehl. After frontal assaults against Hardenhauser Forest failed, the division enveloped the woods by 7 Apr 45. The 255th Inf reached the Kocher River and established a bridgehead at Weissbach 9 Apr 45.

The Kocher River bridgehead was expanded against strong German opposition and the 10th Armd Div attacked out of it 11 Apr 45. The division mopped up in that area and consolidated 14 Apr 45, returning to the attack the next day as it took Schwaebisch Hall with armored support by 18 Apr 45. The division seized the Rems Bridge at Unt Boeblingen on 22 Apr 45 and leapfrogged battalions to reach the Danube River 25 Apr 45. The 254th Inf crossed the river on a damaged bridge in Riedheim and repulsed a German armored counterattack. The division was relieved 28 Apr 45 and withdrawn from the line. It was assigned security duty from the Rhine to Darmstadt and Wurzburg on a line to Stuttgart and Speyer, and was in this mode when hostilities were declared ended on 7 May 45.

Norridgewock Boy Reported Killed In Action

NORRIDGEWOCK, Feb. 20—Mr. And Mrs. Vaughn Chase of Norridgewock, formerly of Perham, Me., have received word that their son, Sgt. Claude Chase, 19, was killed in action on January 29, 1945, while serving with the infantry in France.

Sgt. Chase entered the Army in January 1944 and received his training at Camp Van Dorn, Mississippi. He arrived overseas in December, 1944.
